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SECTION I. INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

A. Introduction

1. CIPET: Institute of Plastics Technology (IPT), is a unit of CIPET established at Kochi, Kerala. CIPET: IPT is the model centre for Skill development, Technology support, Academics and Research (STAR) activities in Biopolymer Science & Technology and focuses on promoting Bioplastics and allied industries. This centre is also extends technical guidance and advisory services to the existing industries and serve as an impetus for entrepreneurs for venturing into establishment of Bioplastics based manufacturing industries.

B. THE BIDDING DOCUMENTS

2. Content of Bidding Documents

- 2.1 The Bidding Documents include;
- (a) Instruction to Bidders;
- (b) Terms and Conditions of Contract;
- (c) Schedule of Requirements;
- (d) Technical Specifications;
- (e) Manufacturer's Authorization Form;
- (f) Bid Form and Price Schedules;
- (g) Contract Form;
- (h) Performance Security Form;
- (i) Deviation Statement;
- 2.2 The Bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the Bidding Documents. Failure to furnish all information required by the Bidding Documents or submission of a bid not substantially responsive to the Bidding Documents in every respect will be at the Bidder's risk and may result in rejection of the bid.

3. Amendment of Bidding Documents

- 3.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, the Purchaser may, for any reason, whether at their own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective bidder, modify the Bidding Documents by amendment.
- 3.2 In order to afford prospective Bidders reasonable time in which to take the amendment into account in preparing their bid, the Purchaser may, at their discretion, extend the deadline for the submission of bids.

C. PREPARATION OF BIDS

4. Documents Comprising the Bid

- 4.1 The bid prepared by the Bidder shall comprise the following components:
- (a) A Bid Form and Price Schedule completed in accordance with Clauses 5 and 6;
- (b) Documentary evidence establishing in accordance with Clause 7, that the Bidder is eligible to bid and is qualified to perform the contract, if its bid is accepted;
- (c) Documentary evidence establishing in accordance with Clause 8, that the goods (machinery/equipment/software) and ancillary services are conforming to the Bidding Documents;

5. Bid Form

The Bidder shall complete the Bid Form and the appropriate Price Schedule furnished in the Bidding Documents, indicating for the goods to be supplied, a brief description of the Goods, their country of origin, quantity and prices.

6. Bid Prices

- 6.1 The Bidder shall indicate on the price schedule attached to these documents, the unit prices and total Bid Prices of the goods, proposed to supply under the Contract.
- 6.2 Fixed Price: Prices quoted by the Bidders shall be fixed during the Bidder's performance of the Contract and not subject to variation on any account. A bid submitted with an adjustable price quotation will be treated as non-responsive and rejected.
- 6.3 Agents and service facilities in India:
- If a foreign bidder has engaged an Indian agent, it will be required to give the following details in the offer:
- (i) The name and address of the local agent;
- (ii) What service the agent renders; and
- (iii) The amount of remuneration for the agent included in the offer.

7. Documents establishing Bidder's Eligibility and Qualifications

- 7.1 Pursuant to Clause 4, the Bidder shall furnish, as part of its bid, documents establishing the bidder's eligibility to bid and its qualifications to perform the Contract if its bid is accepted.
- 7.2 The documentary evidence of the Bidder's qualifications to perform the Contract if its bid is accepted, shall establish to the Purchaser's satisfaction:

- (a) that, in the case of a Bidder offering to supply goods under the contract which the Bidder did not manufacture or otherwise produce, the Bidder has been duly authorized (as per authorization form in Section V) by the goods manufacturer or producer to supply the goods in India.
- (b) that, in the case of a Bidder not doing business within India, the Bidder is or will be (if successfully represented by an agent in India) equipped and able to carry out the Supplier's maintenance, repair and spare-parts stocking obligations prescribed by the Conditions of the Contract and / or Technical Specifications
- (c) that the Bidder has the financial, technical, and production capability necessary to perform the Contract and meets the criteria outlined in the qualification criteria specified in Section VIII (Bidders should furnish information on their past performance and Proforma in Section-VIII A).

8. Documents Establishing Goods' Eligibility and Conformity to Bidding Documents

- 8.1 The Bidder shall furnish, as part of its bid, documents establishing the eligibility and conformity to the Bidding Documents of all goods and services which the bidder proposes to supply under the Contract.
- 8.2 The documentary evidence of the goods and services eligibility shall consist of a statement in the Price Schedule on the country of origin of the goods and services which shall be confirmed by a certificate of origin at the time of shipment.
- 8.3 The documentary evidence of the goods and services conformity to the Bidding Documents may be in the form of literature, drawings and data, and shall furnish:
- (a) a detailed description of the goods essential, technical and performance characteristics;
- (b) a list giving full particulars, including available sources and current prices, of all spare parts, special tools, etc., may be quoted as an additional cost, which may be considered if required; and
- (c) a clause-by-clause commentary on the Purchaser's Technical Specifications demonstrating the goods and services substantial responsiveness to those specifications or a statement of deviations and exceptions to the provisions of the Technical Specifications (As per deviation statement in section IX Annexured)
- 8.4 For purposes of the commentary, the Bidder shall note that standards for workmanship, material and equipment, and references to brand names or catalogue numbers designated by the Purchaser in its Technical Specifications are intended to be descriptive only and not restrictive. The Bidder may substitute alternative standards, brand names and/or catalogue numbers in its bid, provided that it demonstrates to the Purchaser's satisfaction that, the substitutes are substantially equivalent or superior to those designated in the Technical Specifications.

9. Period of Validity of Bids

- 9.1 Bids shall remain valid for 90 days after the date of bid opening prescribed by the Purchaser. A bid valid for a shorter period may be rejected by the Purchaser as non-responsive.
- 9.2 In exceptional circumstances, the Purchaser may solicit the Bidder's consent to an extension of the period of validity. The request and the responses thereto shall be made in writing (or by cable or fax or e-mail). A Bidder may refuse the request without forfeiting its bid security. A Bidder granting the request is not be required or permitted to modify its bid.

10. Submission of Bids

10.1 The detailed technical specification of the equipment is enclosed as Section IV of Bid document, Offer should be of two parts Viz., "TECHNICAL BID" and "COMMERCIAL BID" The content of the both bids should be as under;

(a) TECHNICAL BID should include the following: -

- 1. Detailed specification of the base equipment along with the specification of essential accessories, which are necessary for the functioning of base equipment to be included in the Base unit.
- 2. Deviation Statement
- 3. Product Literature
- 4. Proforma for Performance Statement
- 5. Qualification Criteria
- 6. List of spare parts included along with the machines (the acceptance and rejection of spare parts will be at sole discretion of CIPET: IPT)
- 7. List of optional accessories with their technical specification.
- 8. Manufacturer's Authorization Form
- 9. Bid Form
- 10. Any other information which the bidder would like to state about the technically of the equipment.

(b) COMMERCIAL BID should include the following: -

- 1. The cost of Base unit (including the essential accessories necessary for functioning of Base equipment.
- 2. Optional accessories and spare parts which is mentioned in the technical bid should be quoted in the respective columns provided. (The acceptance and rejection of spare parts as per requirement will be at sole discretion of CIPET: IPT.)
- 3. Conditional bids will not be accepted. The condition laid down by CIPET: IPT is final and binding on all bidders.
- 4. The quote should be in Indian Currency (INR).

5. CIPET: IPT reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders either in part or in full without assigning any reasons thereof.

The bids, which are not containing the statements, mentioned in 10.1 (a) & (b) are liable to be rejected.

- 10.2 The proforma of Annexures (Sections) in the Bidding document, wherever necessary, should be typed on the bidder's letter head and upload the same.
- 10.3 Price Schedule should be submitted in the prescribed format given under price schedule of the Bidding Document.
- 10.4 The Deviation Statement enclosed should be duly filled in and submitted along with Bidding Document. If the bidder is offering more than one options/models, a separate deviation statement for each of such quotes should be submitted along with the offer.
- 10.5 Quotes received without price schedule, and deviation statement as per our prescribed format, will summarily be rejected.

11. Deadline for Submission of Bids

The Purchaser may, at its discretion, extend this deadline for submission of bids by amending the Bid Documents in accordance with Clause 3, in which case all rights and obligations of the Purchaser and Bidders previously subject to the deadline will thereafter be subject to the dead-line as extended.

12. Evaluation and Comparison of Bids

- 12.1 The Purchaser will evaluate and compare the bids previously determined to be substantially responsive.
- 12.2 The availability in India of spare parts and after-sales services for the equipment offered (imported goods) in the bid; (the inclusion of cost of spare parts for comparison as per requirement will be at sole discretion of CIPET: IPT). CIPET: IPT reserves right to accept or to reject any or all bids either in part or in full without assigning any reasons thereof.

13. Contacting the Purchaser

No Bidder shall contact/correspond / communicate the Purchaser on any matter relating to the bid at any time.

D. AWARD OF CONTRACT

14. Post qualification

- 14.1 The Purchaser will determine to its satisfaction whether the Bidder selected as having submitted the lowest evaluated responsive bid is qualified to satisfactorily perform the Contract.
- 14.2 The determination will take into account the Bidder's financial, technical and production capabilities. It will be based upon an examination of the documentary evidence of the Bidder's qualifications submitted by the Bidder, pursuant to Clause 8, as well as such other information as the Purchaser deems necessary and appropriate.
- 14.3 An Affirmative determination will be a prerequisite for award of the Contract to the Bidder. A negative determination will result in rejection of the Bidder's bid,

15. Purchaser's right to vary Quantities at the Time of Award

The Purchaser reserves the right at the time of award of Contract to increase or decrease of the quantity of goods and services specified in the Schedule of Requirements without any change in price or other terms and conditions.

16. Purchaser's Right to Accept any Bid and to Reject Any or All Bids

The Purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or Bidders or any obligation to inform the affected Bidders or Bidders of the grounds for the purchaser's action.

17. Performance Security

Performance security of 5% of total amount shall be kept for a period of 60 days from the date of completion of the work in all respect.

SECTION - II. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

Special Terms and Conditions / Instructions to Bidder

- 1. The Tenderer is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the Tender Documents. Failure to furnish all information required for the Tender Documents or submission of a Tender not substantially responsive to the Tender Documents in every respect will be at the Tenderer's risk and may result in rejection of the Tender.
- 2. The purchaser shall not be liable for any expenses whatsoever incurred by the Tenderer in the preparation of the tender whether his tender is accepted or not even if the purchaser opts for complete withdrawal of invitation of Tender.
- 3. The Tenderer is advised in his own interest to examine the Installation Site of CIPET Institute and Hostel premises before submission of the bid.
- 4. Installation of Cameras at various places of Institute and Hostel at CIPET: IPT, Kochi premises is as per the details provided by CIPET Authority.
- 5. Supplier shall be solely responsible for any defect in Items, quality of material etc. which may result in poor quality.
- 6. Exact specification along with Catalogue/ Photos of the items quoted should be submitted with suitable packing along with the Technical Bid.
- 7. Documentary evidence (signed by authorized signatory) proving that bidder fulfills the criteria as stated in Pre qualification criteria.
- 8. Offer should be in two parts Viz., "TECHNICAL BID" and "FINANCIAL BID" and all bids must be submitted through the online portal www.tenderwizard.com/CIPET.
- 9. Any Tender received by the Purchaser after the deadline for submission of E-Tenders prescribed by the Purchaser, will be rejected. Conditional tender will be summarily rejected without prejudice so bidders are advised to quote the price as per N.I.T. conditions only.
- 10. Tenders shall remain valid for 90 days after the date of E-Tender and incase of Rate Contract it should be valid for 1 year.
- 11. The work should be completed within 1 weeks time from the date of issue of the Purchase Order / Work Order.
- 12. In case of non completion of work in all aspect as per the requirement within 1 Week from the date of issue of the Purchase Order / Work Order CIPET has right to charge liquidated damages @ 0.50% per week subject to maximum of 10% of the total purchase value.
- 13. The cost of tender document is Rs.590/- (Non Refundable) and Tenderers are requested to submit the tender fees on or before 01.10.2019, 17.00 Hrs, by Demand Draft drawn in favor of "CIPET: IPT, Kochi " payable at Ernakulam, failing which the tender will be rejected.
- 14. Performance security of 5% of total amount shall be kept for a period of 60 days from the date of completion of the work in all respect.
- 15.TDS (Tax Deducted at Source) and other applicable taxes will be deducted as per prevailing rules and regulations of the Government, as applicable.

- 16. The Tenderer shall complete the Tender Form and fill the appropriate Financial Bid Furnished in the Tender Documents, indicating for the goods to be supplied, a brief description of the Goods, quantity and prices.
- 17. The Bidder shall indicate on the Financial Bid attached to these documents, the unit prices and total Bid Prices of the goods, proposed to be supplied under the Contract.
- 18. Financial Bid should be submitted in the prescribed format (Excel Format) given under price schedule of the Tender Document.
- 19. The rate quoted by the Tenderer should be firm and no escalation on any account whatsoever shall be paid for this work.
- 20. CIPET will notify the successful Tenderer in writing by registered letter / e-mail to be confirmed that his tender has been accepted.
- 21.100% amount shall be paid after successful supply, commissioning, configuration of entire system & testing of CCTV Cameras at the CIPET: IPT, Kochi as per the confirmation and on actual quantity ordered and received.
- 22. The suppliers shall be solely responsible for supplying the given models and installing them in the CIPET, Kochi Institute.
- 23. Selection and short listing of the models of cameras will be the sole discretion of CIPET.
- 24. The Principal Director & Head, CIPET: IPT, Kochi reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders at any point of time prior to issue of Purchase Order without assigning any reasons whatsoever and no correspondence shall be entertained in this regard.
- 25. In the case of a dispute or differences arising between the Purchaser and Supplier relating to any matter arising out or connected with this Tender, such dispute or differences shall be referred within the Jurisdiction of the Court, Ernakulam, Kerala.
